Soft play is very heavy to lift and manoeuvre	Those who are transporting the soft play, setting it up, or packing it away could injure their backs	2	1	To move the soft play a suitable trolley will be used wherever possible  Advice will be followed on correct lifting procedures to prevent injury (using guidance from www.hse.gov.uk or other sources)  The soft play will be packed away as directed by the manufactures instructions, and secured with the straps provided where required	Rob - Bounce & Party

Long electric power cable	Those who are setting up other stalls at the event could trip on the cable	2	1	Secure the power cable to the ground as soon as it is laid down, and do not remove the tape until cable is due to be wound up	Rob - Bounce & Party
Damage to the electric power cable	Anybody who touches the damaged cable could be electrocuted	1	3	Unroll the electric cable, and check the full length of the cable, plus any plugs or sockets  Ensure that the power cable is plugged into power supply that has a trip switch OR use the power breaker supplied	Rob - Bounce & Party
Outdoor: Heavy duty stakes to be driven in using mallet, and removed at the end of the day	Those banging in the stakes could hit their hands Others in the area could be hit with the mallet	1	2	Hold the stakes halfway down when banging them in Knock the stakes sideways using the mallet before trying to pull them out  Make sure the area is clear of other people	Rob - Bounce & Party
Indoor: 25kg sand bags to be used and removed at the end of the day	Those carrying the sand bags to the location  Others tripping over the sandbags	2	1	Moving and handling procedures to be used.  Suitable wheeled trolly to be used  Sand bags to be easily seen and attached to the bouncy caste	Rob - Bounce & Party
The soft play is wet when it's put away	Those packing away the soft play could be injured as it will be slippery and heavier if wet.	2	2	If possible, the soft play will be dried out before it is put away	Rob - Bounce & Party

Using the bouncy castle: At least one adult will supervise the Bouncy Castle at all times

Larger children colliding with smaller children	Smaller children could be injured	2	3	The height restriction of 1m, and age restriction of unto 5 years, will be strictly enforced by those supervising the soft play  A maximum number of children using the equipment will be limited	Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Children jumping off or falling off the soft play	Children could be seriously injured	1	3	Children should only play with the soft play on the safety mats provided  At least one adult supervisor will be supervising the soft play	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Children colliding with each other whilst using the soft play	Children could be injured	3	1	Responsible adult supervising the soft play will ensure that children do not bump into each other or become overly boisterous	Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Sharp objects that could injure children or damage the equipment	Children using the soft play could be injured by sharp objects	1	3	The soft play will not be set up on areas where there are sharp objects or gravel and will be checked thoroughly before it is used  Children will be asked to remove their shoes and any other sharp objects before they use the soft play	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client

Outdoor: Soft play gets wet due to rain Indoor: Soft play gets wet	Children might slip and injure themselves	2	2	The soft play will not be used if it rains, and will be dried completely before children are allowed on it  Food and drink will not be allowed on or near the soft play	Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
People using the soft play after the event has finished and it is not longer being supervised	People could disregard the guidelines for safe use of the soft play, and injure themselves or others.  If they were injured, there may not be anyone nearby to help them.	2	3	The soft play will be supervised all the time that it is setup, and will be packed away as soon as possible after the event has finished.	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Adverse weather conditions – RAIN.	Children using the soft play may slip as surfaces when wet become slippery	1	3	Bounce & Party will not hire the equipment if the MET office weather forecast is wet or is likely to cause injury  The equipment is not to be used when raining or when wet, no users are allowed on the equipment whilst the entrance / exit or play area is bubbling or wet.  Explain to the hirer what to do if it starts to rain during the hire or if the equipment becomes wet  Ensure that the hirer is aware of the wet weather policy upon arrival and correct supervision is maintained at all times.	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client

Averse weather Conditions - Wind	Children using the soft play may be blown over or hit by other objects due to weather conditions	1	3	Bounce & Party will not hire the equipment if the MET office weather forecast is wet or is likely to cause injury  Soft play is not permitted to be used in strong winds (over 24 mph) including gusts. Windy conditions can be deemed a health and safety risk.  In the event of strong winds after set up, remove the children from the soft play	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Balls / soft play being thrown.	Children may be hit by balls being thrown	1	1	Responsible person supervising at all times. Throwing balls, shapes or equipment is NOT PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Injury through de lamination or foam being exposed.	Children being exposed to the foam	1	1	Visual inspections during set up and test annually from defects.	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Emergency.	Anyone attending the party or event	1	3	In the event that someone is seriously injured, DO NOT move the individual, remove all users from the equipment and dial 999 immediately.	Responsible adult provided by the customer / client

Fire	Anyone attending the party or event	1	3	No smoking or barbecues near the equipment at any time.	Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
Chocking	Anyone attending the party or event	1	3	No food, drinks, chewing gum, balloons, silly string or alike to be allowed on or near the equipment or soft play.  Ensure users don't put ball pit balls in their mouths; this also is for HYGIENE REASONS.  Use of commercial 7/8cm BS grade balls means they are too big to placed in the mouth.	Rob - Bounce & Party  Responsible adult provided by the customer / client
